As a representative of the Monterey Bay Central Labor Council, which represents 60 unions and more than 31,000 workers in Monterey and Santa Cruz counties, I write to express our support for the Monterey Travelodge workers. The contract proposal you submitted to HERE-UNITE was an appalling sign of disrespect to Travelodge workers and the hard work that they do. It is the worst contract offer we have seen in many years, and is outright unacceptable.

The hardworking women and men at Travelodge Monterey deserve fair compensation for their work—this includes health insurance, pension contributions and fair wage increases. The Monterey Bay Central Labor Council will stand in support of these workers, and will demand that you negotiate a fair contract with them.
